


CPC+ Medicare Payments

Calendar Year 2017


To support the delivery of comprehensive primary care, CPC+ includes three payment elements. These are: **care management fees**; prospective **performance-based incentive payments (PBIP)** subject to reconciliation; and a hybrid of fee-for-service (FFS) and **Comprehensive Primary Care Payments (CPCP)** for Track 2 practices.



TOTAL CPC+ PAYMENTS BY REGION (in millions of dollars)




TOTAL CPC+ PAYMENTS BY TRACK (in millions of dollars)

- ◆ 10% CPCP / 90% FFS
- ◆ 25% CPCP / 75% FFS
- ◆ 40% CPCP / 60% FFS
- ◆ 65% CPCP / 35% FFS

* CPCP values represent 9 months of payment. Track 2 practices began receiving the CPCP in Quarter 2 2017.
** Estimated Medicare FFS expenditures based on a 12-month average from Jul 2016 – Jun 2017
