The purpose of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) Health Services Research Grant Program is to support HBCU researchers in carrying out health services research activities to meet the needs of diverse CMS beneficiary populations. This is the 19<sup>th</sup> year for the grant program. The goals of the grant program are to:

1. Encourage HBCU health services researchers to pursue research issues which impact the Medicare, Medicaid, and Children Health Insurance programs;
2. Assist CMS in implementing its mission focusing on health care quality and improvement for its beneficiaries;
3. Assist HBCU researchers by supporting extramural research in health care capacity development activities for the African American communities;
4. Increase the pool of HBCU researchers capable of implementing the research, demonstration, and evaluation activities of CMS;
5. Promote research that will be aimed at developing a better understanding of health care services pertained to African Americans; and
6. Assist in fostering inter-university communication and collaboration regarding African American health disparity issues.

The purpose of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' Hispanic Grant Program is to implement Hispanic American health services research activities to meet the needs of diverse CMS beneficiary populations. This is the 17<sup>th</sup> year for the grant program. The grant program is designed to:

1. Encourage health services researchers to pursue research issues which impact Hispanic Medicare, Medicaid, and Children Health Insurance programs;
2. Conduct outreach activities to apprise Hispanic researchers of funding availability to conduct research related issues affecting Hispanic American communities to expand the pool of applicants applying for such grants;
3. Assist CMS in implementing its mission focusing on health care quality and improvement for its beneficiaries;
4. Support extramural research in health care capacity development activities for the Hispanic American communities;
5. Promote research that will be aimed at developing a better understanding of health care services issues pertaining to Hispanic Americans, and
6. Foster a network for communication and collaboration regarding Hispanic health care issues.
